


Members will benefit from an extensive range of activities to assist and promote the construction industry:

What we know about our market



The building and construction industry is the nation's second largest industry but only 11% of women make up its total workforce and only 1% of building trades. However, despite these low numbers, women are achieving major success in the industry every day and the percentage of women in construction is rising.



South Australia (+8.2%) saw strong gains in the construction employment headcount over the previous 12 months.



The number of women employed in SA construction rose from 8,933 in November 2019 to 10,409 in November 2020, a rise of some +16.5% or 1,476 women working in the construction industry.
