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

A MESSAGE FROM THE PREMIER

As our state emerges from the uncertainty of the pandemic, I firmly believe that we have a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to build a better South Australia – and that "build" is the operative word.

Since March 19 my government has been focussed on delivering on our election promises, including those we made to the construction industry to set our state up for the years and decades ahead - and I'm proud to say that we have hit the ground running.

Over the next three years Renewal SA is delivering a pipeline of new residential projects and development opportunities valued at approximately \$2 billion.

We are fulfilling our promise to invest in our public housing stock, building 400 new dwellings – 250 in metropolitan Adelaide and 150 in the regions – and restoring a further 350 untenanted homes in need of major works, as well as engaging in a state-wide maintenance blitz to upgrade a further 3000 properties.

We're also looking after our public schools, with \$26.6 million committed over the next two years to a comprehensive program of well-deserved upgrades.

And of all our infrastructure work comes with a staunch policy commitment to use SA-based lead and sub-contractors, and to prioritise local suppliers wherever possible. And as part of that promise, we have committed \$214,000 a year to the Office of the Industry Advocate to assist local businesses to become tender-ready through regular industry-specific workshops.

My government has also committed to a requirement that across major building and civil infrastructure projects contracted at over \$50 million, there will be a target that 90 per cent of the combined labour hours will go to \$A workers – supporting local jobs and keeping public money in the state economy.

Speaking of workers, my government enthusiastically supports the work of Mates In Construction, and our budget reiterated our commitment to their vital work in suicide prevention and mental health management in the construction building, mining and energy industries. To that end, we have increased the level of ongoing funding toward their important programmes to \$60,000 per annum.

We have also followed through on our pre-election commitment to provide \$125,000 per annum to the Master Builder's Association to support the costs of the Building Ideas television program.

That's what we've done in the immediate term – but at the same time we're focusing on the future of our state, our building industry, and our people.

We recognise the urgent need for developing local skills and have committed to investing in education and training for the next generation. We reversed the punitive cuts the previous government imposed on TAFE courses, committing \$2.2 million per annum to fund qualifications in many areas in which there is a current skill shortage, such as bricklaying, concreting, and saw doctoring.

We are also creating five new technical colleges in South Australia to ensure a steady increase in qualified workers in our skilled trades in Findon, Modbury Heights, Port Augusta, and Mount Gambier.

And my government is providing \$250,000 a year to the Master Builders Association to run a school outreach program to encourage students to take up a fulfilling and rewarding career in the building trades.

This is an exciting time for South Australia, filled with opportunities to build a better future for our state – and the building and construction industry is key to our prosperity and security.

Congratulations to all those recognised by the Master Builders Association and thank you for continuing to build a bright future for South Australia.

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














HiViZ Women Building SAOutstanding Woman In Construction 2022






Builders' ChoiceTrade Contractor Award 2022

This magnificent restoration of a four-storey building to practical completion within nine months, involved complex planning, use of technology such as drones and 3D modelling, restoring, or replacing a wide array of heritage materials and carefully installing modern commercial building requirements, all whilst meeting the State Heritage requirements. The superb result confirms Hansen Yuncken is worthy of this award.
